ADDED MONEY AT NCHA & APHA EVENTS!

Is my horse eligible?

- If your horse has two inches of solid white above the middle of the knee or hock and behind the eye, you possibly have an APHA eligible horse.

How it works ...

- Look for the "Chrome Cash" class at 2020 NCHA aged events and enter!
- \$2,000 added money to the Chrome Cash Paint Horse classes at select NCHA aged events in 2020. (Not all shows with the Chrome Cash will have added money.)
- \$14,000 added money at the APHA World Show Cutting Challenge in Fort Worth in July 2020.

How do I qualify?

- Register your horse with APHA
- Enter the "Chrome Cash Paint" class at designated shows

FAQ

Q. My horse is already AQHA registered, can it also be APHA registered?

A. *AQHA horses that meet APHA registration rules can possibly be double registered with APHA & AQHA. Being double registered may increase your horses' value while opening up opportunities to compete at more events.*

Q. My horses' sire and dam are Quarter Horses so how can my horse be a Paint?

A. *Regardless of lineage, if a horse meets the required minimum white markings he/she could be registered APHA.*

Q. I have a broodmare/stallion that is registered APHA based on white markings, what if the foals don't meet the white marking rules?

A. *All foals by/out of APHA registered stock may be eligible to be APHA registered regardless of color.*

Chrome Cash Rules

- Horse must be registered APHA. Both Regular Registry and Solid Paint-Bred registered horses are eligible.
- Owner must be current APHA member in good standings.
- Chrome Cash class must be entered per each events rules. Must complete entry form, pay fees and submit APHA registration papers to show secretary to qualify.
- Only shows designated with Chrome Cash Sponsors will have added money. However the Chrome Cash class will be available at additional participating NCHA events.
- The Chrome Cash class is a class within a class and no working finals.
- Added money will be divided in direct proportion to the entries qualifying in each class.
- Chrome Cash rules will follow Jackpotted Class rules set by NCHA and each event producer. See individual NCHA event rules for more details.
